unnamd and unboquethed I give to my beloved wife Elizabeth Bonnet
whome I make full and sole executrix of this my last will and testament
to discharge all debte and legacies and to do what she shall see to her to
do as my executrix. In witness whereof, I have set to my hand and seale
this twelfth nyth day of January one thousand six hundred fifty eight
Richard Bonnet his maner in the presence of James Winton Richard of
Buckenbury his maner Thomas Leaver.

of wills and granting thereof lawfully authorized the eighteenth day of
June in the yeare of our Lord one thousand six hundred fifty nyne by the
oath of Elizabeth Bonnet Robert and sole executrix named in the
said will to whome was committed shew of all and singular goodie realtates
debte of this said deceased this being first sworn by the said executrix to do
May 6th 1659.

portions. Item I give also to my said executrix one tenement in Church
in the parish of Belfry now in the tenure and occupation of George Hodgson
being five pounde seven shillings Rent by the yeare to be by my said
executrix sold for and towards the raisinge of portions for the children.
Item I give unto Robert Bonnet my eldest sonne five pounde in case
he be dead then it shall appertaine to my executrix. Item I give also to my
son William Bonnet eight pounde to be paid him by my executrix within
six monethes after my decease. Item I give unto Thomas Bonnet my son
fourte shillings to be paid him by my executrix when he attains his
the age of one and twenty yeares. Item I give unto my son Charles Bonnet
Bonnet nyne and twenty pounde to be paid him by my executrix when he
attains unto the yeares of one and twenty. Item I give unto John Bonnet
Bonnet my son twenty nyne pounde to be paid him by my executrix when
he comes to the yeares of one and twenty. Item I give also to my son
Henry Bonnet twenty nyne pounde to be paid him by my said executrix
when he attains to the yeares of one and twenty. Item I give also to Mary
Bonnet my daughter eight pounde when she attains to the yeares of
one and twenty. Item I give also to Shes Bonnet my daughter thirty nyne
pounde to be paid her by my executrix when she attains unto the yeares
of

of one and twenty, And I doe hereby make and appoint Martin Bonnet my
 sonne to be my only and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament if in
 my minde and will further is that if any of my children aforesaid shall dye
 before they attaine the yeres of one and twenty that their share or portions
 shall be by my said Executor equally divided amongst the surviving children
 If I give also unto John Hardy and Mary Hardy my grandchilden five
 shillinge a yeare to be paid them by my said Executor when they come to the
 yeres of one and twenty If I doe also make Robert Salterne of Sperrin
 the parish of Bilsby and Christopher Salterne of Cruthorpe in the Countie
 aforesaid to be Supervisors of this my last will and Testament and for the
 truth and fidelity of this Supervisors I give each of them five shillinge
